

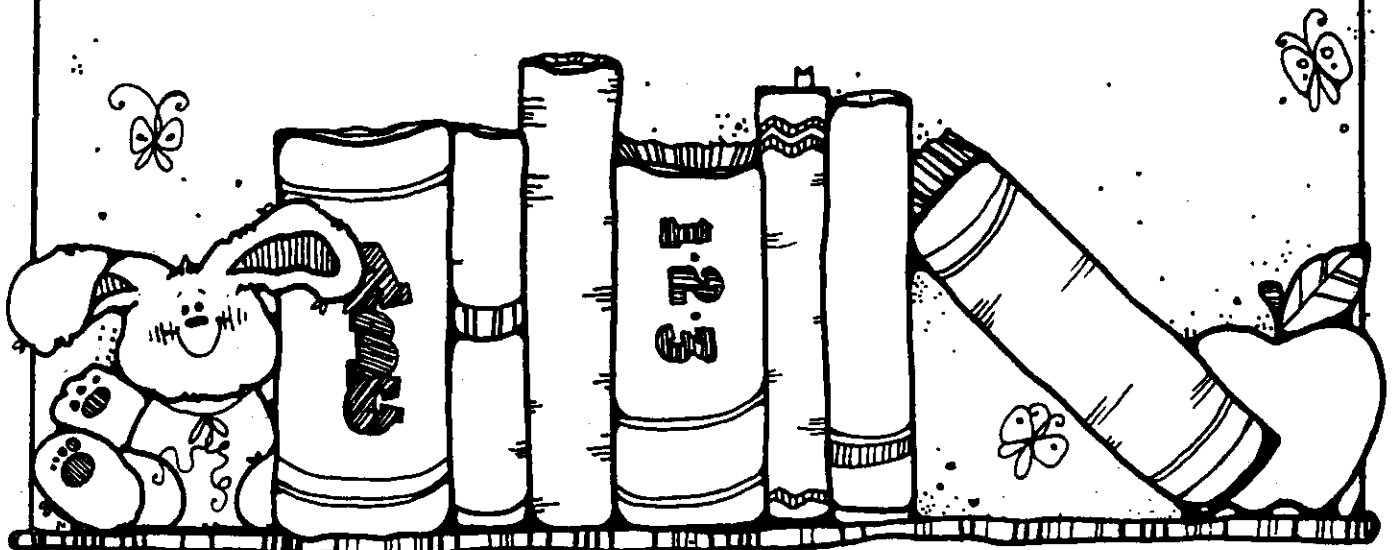


## General Kindergarten Supply List 2009-10

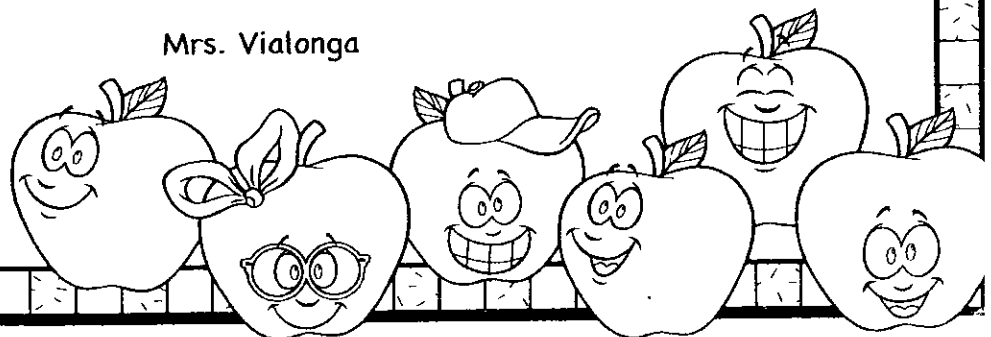
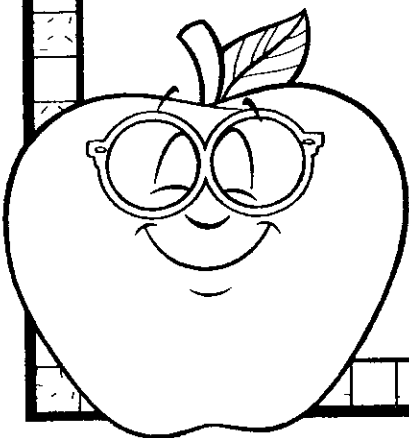
